IN CITY COUNCIL

May 24, 1976

ORDERED:

On the petition of the City Manager of the City of Cambridge, that the Commissioner of Public Works be authorized under the provisions of the City Ordinances, to grant a permit or license to the Cambridge School Department or their duly authorized agent to erect a projection over the public way on Cambridge Street in conjunction with the construction of the new High School Complex.

Said projection to extend over the public way on Cambridge Street at a point between the present Rindge Technical School and the War Memorial to be ninety-two feet eight inches in length with a height above the grade ranging from fourteen feet nine inches to fifteen feet three inches with a width of nine feet from the property line of the Library Park area and will be constructed in such a manner that the edge of the projection stops two feet one inch of the curb line; no footings or posts will be installed along the sidewalk in connection with this projection all as shown on diagram dated March 5, 1976 entitled "Cambridge Street Cross Section."

Provided that, before erecting the above named projection the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Twenty-Five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said projection over the sidewalk.

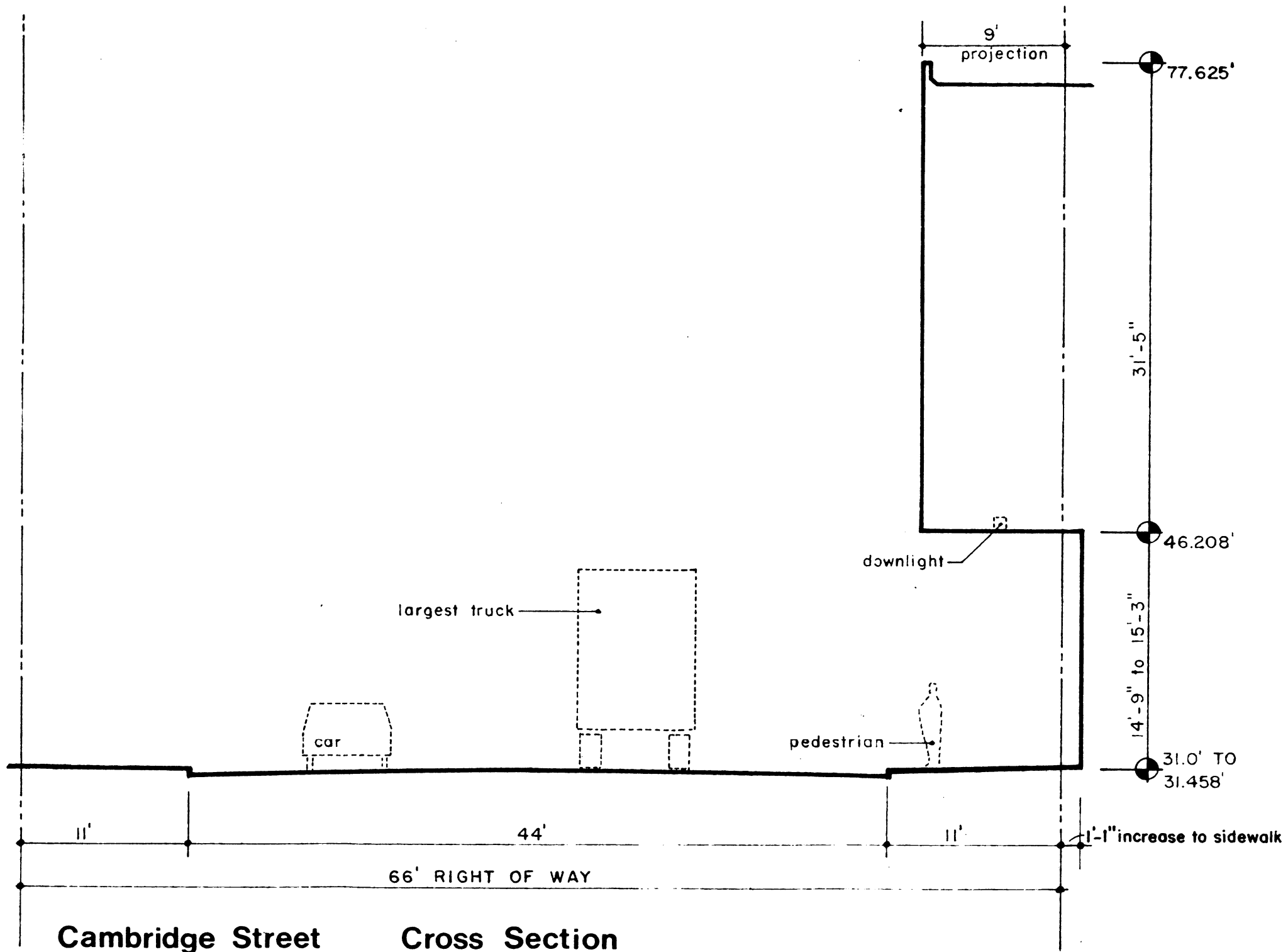

To the Honorable, the City Council:

The following is a request to the City Council for a permit to erect a projection over the public way on Cambridge Street, in connection with the new High School.

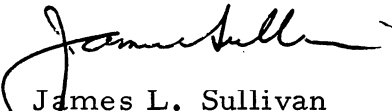
The plans for the new High School include the construction of a new building along Cambridge Street. The new building will be three stories high, the upper two stories projecting out over the public way. As depicted on the attached Cross Section, the dimensions of the projection will be:

Height above grade:	14'9" - 15'3"
Width:	9'
Length:	92'8"

The width of the sidewalk under the projection will be increased by 1'1", to a total width of 12'1", such that the edge of the projection stops 2'1" short of the curb line. There will be no footings or posts along the sidewalk in connection with this projection.

The design of this projection, as described above, ensures that the sidewalk is not obstructed for the passage of people or of emergency vehicles. It also provides a protected and well-illuminated shelter for students and other people waiting at the bus stop or entering the War Memorial.
