Freedom a new word for Freedom

Such a definition and distinction is needed because the enemies of free societies claim that freedom causes too much disorder.

Freedom is a general word denoting free from being bound. A person has their freedom. They are not bound. The word in general does not connote responsibility.

Anarchy is a form of freedom in which the freedom of some causes harm to others.

However in a law abiding free society freedom means you get to live your basic rights to life the way you want because others respect your right to do so. Those basic rights are Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness. The reason others respect your rights is that you agree to respect their basic life rights.

Therefore in a civilized society freedom involves more than, not being bound or not engaging in anarchy.

In a free society freedom has to involve Respect for each other's common basic rights.

Where there is violence that denies the basic inalienable rights there is no freedom.

The worst form of violence is silent governmental bureaucratic violence. When a government betrays its own people with corruption and thereby steals and drains The People of the opportunities to achieve their basic rights. Then the people in anger commit violence against one another.

So we have created a new word which specifically defines the core need of a free society. Which is the need for respecting each other's rights

We cap the word Free with the word Dome. A dome rises to a unifying point or area.

With this we symbolize that Freedom involves a method of unity. That Freedom means all societal members and societal mechanisms agree to Respect each other's basic rights. That in a society of Freedom there is this included, Responsibility.
