I am in receipt of a copy of the order of the Cambridge City Council adopted on February 9, 1970.

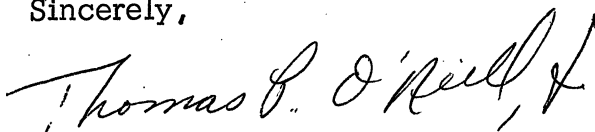
