- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to prepare an ordinance for the consideration of the City Council which would establish a Cambridge Animal Commission, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the City Solicitor to render an opinion as to the legality of the Commission to appoint a director of the Commission under the proposed ordinance, and be it further
- ORDERED: That a copy of any proposed ordinance to establish a Cambridge Animal Commission be furnished to the Dog Officers for their consideration and recommendations, and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to include an additional \$20,000 in his proposed budget for Fiscal Year 1978-79 for an expanded program of Animal Control including provisions for the neuting and spaying of animals.
