ORDERED:

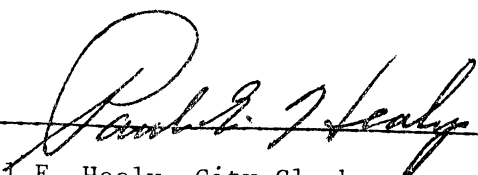

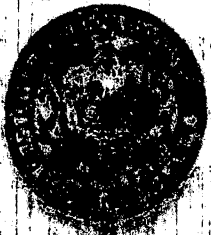

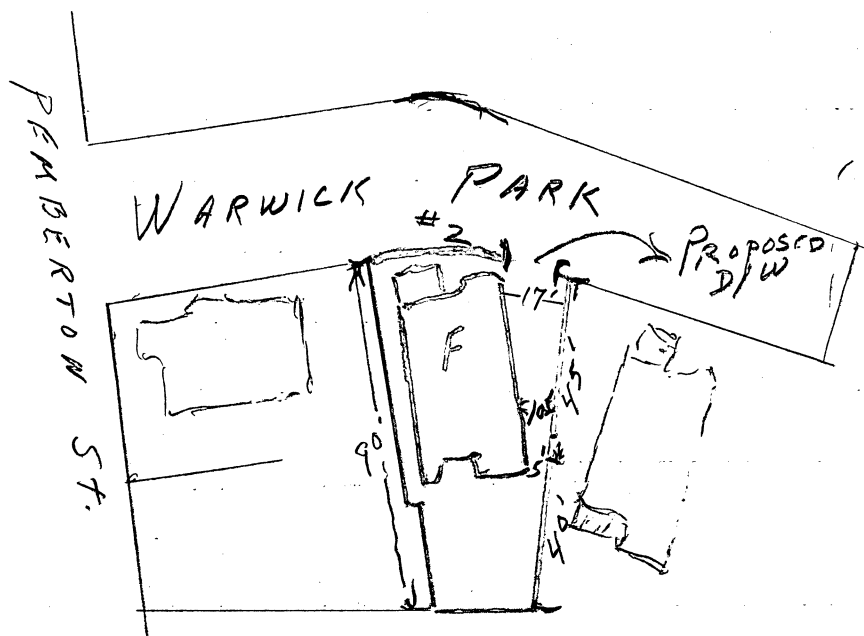
