Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant for \$37,500 from the Massachusetts Committee on Criminal Justice to the Police Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$37,500. The funds will be used to develop, within the Police Department, a formal integrated community policing information network on personal computers.
