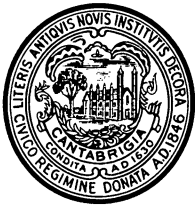


Dear Mr. Sullivan:

The Cambridge Retirement Board finds that our request of March 3, 1975, to transfer \$2,600.00 from our A-1 account to the B-35 account was insufficient.

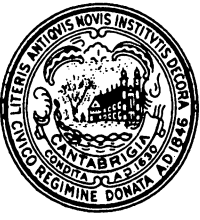


