Dear Cambridge City Council

In accordance with section 98 of Chapter 43 of the Massachusetts General laws, I, Jack the problem solver, a.k.a. George F. Welch Jr, demand to be heard on this Complaint against City Councillor William Walsh, for violations of his duties as chair of the city council cable committee for failing and refusing to submit for public hearing at a city council meeting his report to the city council of the May 30, 1990 cable committee hearing on Continental Cablevision's proposed rate increases and opposition to those proposals.

I also demand to be heard on this Complaint against the City Manager for failing and refusing to act on my requests for videotapes, my request for information regarding the position Cable Commissioner of November 15, 1991 and my requests as set out in my November 14, 1991 Communication, referred to him by you in December and his refusal to act on my request for settlement of the Connorton case.
