ORDERED:-

That, in accordance with the provisions of and ordinance relative to placing and maintaining of signs, the Superintendent of Streets be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit for the erection of a sign to John Sampainko at No 150 Cambridge Street.

Provided that before erecting the above named sign the petitioner shall file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollars conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

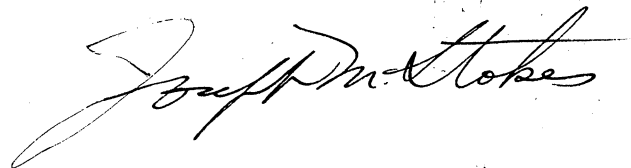
