Whereas this will mark the sixth time that these games will be organized and sponsored by the Department of Human Service Programs

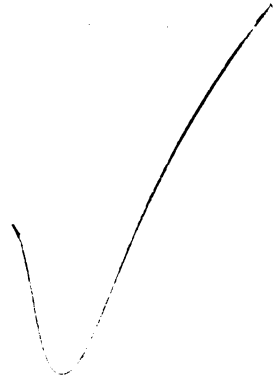
Whereas this event is always well-attended and this year it is expected that more than 500 young people(aged 7-14) boys and girls will participate in the games;
