- WHEREAS: Governor Michael Dukakis appointed former Cambridge employee John P. DeVillars as Secretary of the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs for the Commonwealth; a position which places him in supervisory responsibility for 3,900 public employees throughout this Commonwealth, with an operating budget of \$162 million dollars; and
- WHEREAS: John's first exposure to politics was working in the campaign of State Representative and Council colleague Sandra Graham; exposure which ignited John's political and public service interest; and
- WHEREAS: Subsequently, John began work in the City of Cambridge Budget Office and later served as Administrative Assistant to former Mayors Barbara Ackermann and Walter J. Sullivan prior to leaving municipal government to campaign for the late Indiana Senator Birch Bayh's bid for the office of President; and
- WHEREAS: John received a Bachelor's Degree from the University of Pennsylvania and a Master's Degree in Public Administration from the John F. Kennedy School of Government at Harvard University; having met the Governor at the Kennedy School while he was a Professor and Student Advisor; and association which has kept these gentlemen both professionally and personally close; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating and extending its best wishes to John DeVillars on his recent appointment as Secretary of the Executive Office of Environmental Affairs; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to John on behalf of the entire City Council.
