Subject: Council Order No.16 - 10-15-79 - Mayor Danahy
Repair Rindge Avenue from Sherman Street

Please be advised the Public Works Department has surveyed the street condition of Rindge Avenue in its entirety from Massachusetts Avenue to the Alewife Brook Parkway on the Sherman Street side. As everyone is aware, the street has seriously deteriorated because of the heavy traffic. The street can be repaired by cold planing one lane approximately 10-12 feet wide in order to regrade the gutter and install a 1½" hot top paving course.

This work will cost approximately \$10,000 from Massachusetts Avenue to Middlesex Street and approximately \$17,000 from Middlesex Street to Alewife Brook Parkway.

I am requesting, through the Community Development Department, to see if funds from the Block Grant Contingency can be used for this work. If funds are available, I will schedule this work immediately.

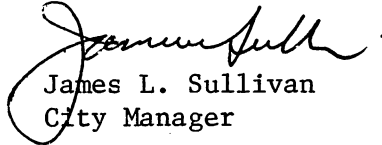
