To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is a copy of the communication received from John R. McCarthy, Secretary of the School Committee, enclosing a copy of the order of the School Committee recommending a budget in the total sum of \$36,717,403.00, which was adopted by the Cambridge School Committee for the next fiscal year. The budget recommended by the School Department is \$1,803,858.00 higher than required to comply with the reductions for 2½. As the Council is aware, based on the preliminary Cherry Sheet loss of \$2,342,451.41, additional aid will be required in that amount to just break even. With the proposal submitted by the School Department combined with the Cherry Sheet shortfall, in order to break even new aid would be required in the amount of \$4,146,309.41, and there would be no funds available for restoring Police or Fire if the School budget is allowed to stand.

This communication is forwarded to you for your information. We have not as yet received the detailed budget in this office. When it is received I will forward it to the Council with my recommendations.
