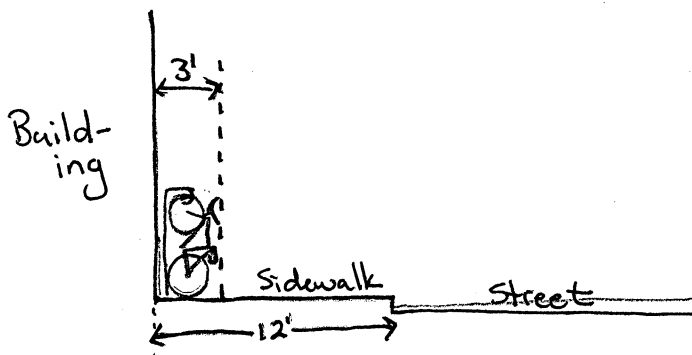

The undersigned respectfully pray

That the Cambridge City Council grant the Broadway Bicycle School, Ltd., a permit to display merchandise on the sidewalk in front of our business at 351 Broadway Street.

We propose using a commercially available bike rack to hang up to a dozen bicycles vertically against the front of our building. The sidewalk at this point is twelve (12) feet wide, and the bicycles would extend out from the building no more than three (3) feet. Thus we would be complying with the city ordinance that displayed merchandise not occupy more than 25% of the sidewalk width.

We are a small business that has been operating at this location for nineteen years, and no one in the neighborhood has ever complained about our bicycles blocking the sidewalk. The vertical rack we are proposing would in fact use one-half the width of the bike rack we previously had on the sidewalk, both for merchandise display and bicycle parking. (We have removed that rack per request of the Cambridge Department of Public Works.)
