

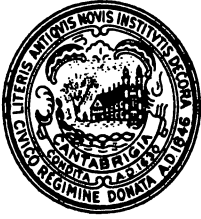

The attached appropriation transfer, in the amount of \$2,500.00 has been requested by the Election Commission in order that they may attend a conference on "Computers in the Election Process". As you may recall, we recently transferred \$8,000.00 from the Reserve Fund to the Election Commission for the software development and staff training costs associated with the new computer system they are initiating.


This conference, scheduled for February 16 - 18 in Colorado Springs, Colorado, should give the Commissioners further insight into the possible applications they could introduce in the future. This will be doubly important if recent federal legislation concerning "postcard" registration and "election day" registration are enacted.
