AMENDED ORDER IN CITY COUNCIL

November 10, 1980

COUNCILLOR VELLUCCI

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct all department heads in the City of Cambridge government to refrain, cease and desist from making harassing public statements or utterances

"that specified numbers of employees in their departments will be laid off because of the adoption of the 2½ law in Massachusetts"

and further that said department heads and the City Manager cease from making harassing statements of lay-offs to their direct employees whether it be in seriousness or in jest; inasmuch as such loose talk is causing mental anxiety in the families of the public service employees.
