To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 25, regarding a report on regulations that govern dog walking at the Cambridge Cemetery, Public Works Commissioner Ralph Dunphy reports the following:

After a review of Chapter 114 of the General Laws of Massachusetts concerning cemeteries, there are no sections that pertain to the governing of dog walking on the grounds of a cemetery.

However, the Cambridge Cemetery does enforce Sections 6.04.030 (Leash and Restraint), which requires the leashing of all dogs and Section 6.04.060 (Removal of Waste Required) in Chapter 6.04 of the City of Cambridge Municipal Codes.
