Any active member of the system may be nominated for this office by obtaining twenty-five (25) signatures of active members indorsing his candidacy. Blanks for the nomination of a candidate may be obtained at the office of the Election Commission. Nomination papers must be filed not later than 4:30 P.M. on March 31st, at this office.

Ballots are to be mailed to members after the nominations are closed. The completed ballot must be returned to the Election Commission office on or before April 15th at NOON, (12 o'clock).
