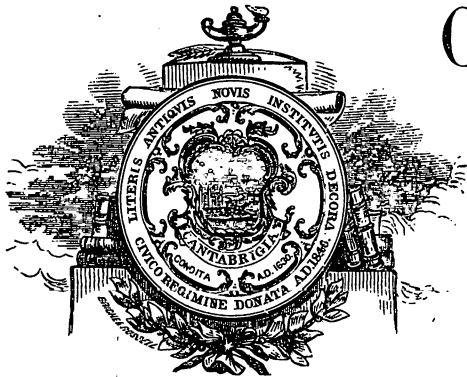




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

April 22/1874,

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Lopez Street

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet* in width between

Pearl and Brookline Sts.

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

E. J. Bowker

Dated September 15, 1873.

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *and that thirty days be allowed for the removal of all fences or other obstructions standing thereon,*
