IN CITY COUNCIL

May 18, 1998

WHEREAS: The City Manager is submitting a grant application to the State's Urban Self-Help Program and the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund to renovate Russell Field in North Cambridge. The amount of the grant is \$500,000 and the filing deadline is June 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS: The City has sought state and federal grant monies for improvements and renovations to Russell Field; now therefore be it

ORDERED: The City Manager is authorized to file, on behalf of the City of Cambridge, any and all applications deemed necessary under the Urban Self Help Program (Chapter 933 of the Acts of 1987, as amended) and the Federal Land and Water Conservation Funds (P.L. 88-568, 78 Stat. 897) for the development of Russell Field, under the care and control of the City of Cambridge, for recreational purposes; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Council acknowledges that the City Manager has designated Richard C. Rossi, Deputy City Manager, as the contact person to answer questions on the application; its intention to approve a budget recommendation for the renovation of Russell Field; and that the grants referenced in this order relate to reimbursement programs, and hereby indicates its intention to approve all additional necessary appropriations to fund these projects, subject to grant awards.
