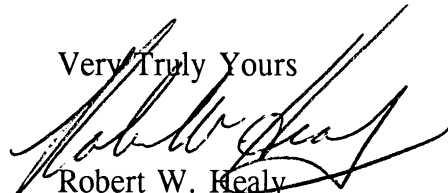

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$1,000.00 in the Grant fund of the License Department (Cambridge Consumer Council) Other Ordinary Maintenance Account from the Executive Office of Elder Affairs.
