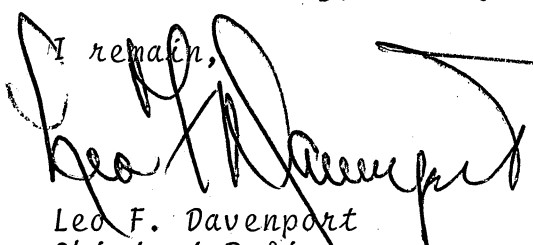
Dear Sir:

In regard to Council Order # 5 dated May 1, 1978 submitted by Councillor Walter J. Sullivan in that it states that the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to either re-institute police officers in and around Cambridge Rindge Latin High School or to increase foot patrols in the area with specific attention being given to the Ellery, Trowbridge and Dana Street area in order to stop the current incidents of vandalism taking place by the high school students.

Sir, please be aware that this Department has not decreased police protection which is afforded in the area of the Rindge Latin High School in the past nor shall it in the present.

The only Officer that may well have left this area is an Officer who was affiliated with the School system for a period of time and his authority was, in most instances, upon the property of the school building, itself.
