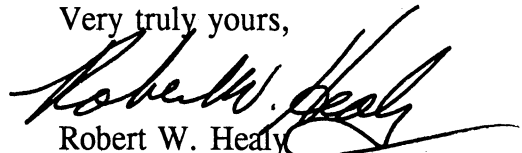

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$10,082.00 in the General Fund of the Cambridge Election Commission from the Salary and Wages Account to the Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. These funds will be used to increase the census mailings from two to three thereby eliminating the need for personnel to conduct door-to-door canvassing. The mailings will be staggered four weeks apart beginning January 8 and ending April 1. This timetable brings us in line with the Commission's legal requirement to complete the census by April 15.
