MAYOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: Rubbish and garbage is frequently placed at the curb to accommodate the schedules of different public and private contractors; and
- WHEREAS: This indiscriminate practice contributes to the unsightliness of our residential and commercial neighborhoods; and
- WHEREAS: Rubbish improperly packaged or set out at the curb at times than otherwise specified by ordinance contributes greatly to the amount of paper and debris in our neighborhoods; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested, working in close cooperation with the business associations, to work out a coordinated schedule of rubbish pickup throughout our commercial areas. This schedule will permit pickup only on specified days at certain hours; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to develop a systematic plan of enforcing the ordinance throughout the city so that rubbish and garbage will heretofor be set at the curb only at the times specified by ordinance; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager, in connection with developing and enforcing these plans and ordinances give wide advance opportunity for consultation and publicity.
