WHEREAS: The traffic ban prohibiting the storage of automobiles on our streets for more than 24 hours has inadvertently victimized many Cambridge residents when in fact it was intended to keep non-residents from using our streets as a parking lot; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to amend this regulation so that cars with Resident Sticker parking in areas posted for Resident Sticker parking will be exempt from the restriction of this regulation.
