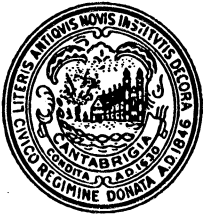

Your authorization is respectfully requested for preliminary appropriations for the following Hospital appropriation codes:

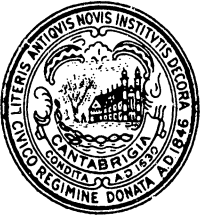
