The undersigned residents and
and landholders upon and near Raymond Street,
so called, respectfully petition your Hon Board
to open said street, immediately, as originally
laid out. Those of the undersigned who have
given up their land upon condition that said
street should be opened within a specified time,
take this occasion to express to your Hon
Board, that damages should be awarded them
if the street is suffered to remain in its present
condition without an opening beyond Lincoln
Street. Your petitioners further desire to express
that the public interest demands the opening
of said street in order to accommodate the
great amount of Carriage and team travel
that is constantly passing into it, presuming
there is an opening at the farther end, nearly
half a mile from its commencement.
