Petition of Boston-Cambridge Trolley Tours, Inc. for a certificate of public convenience and necessity under the provisions of G.L. c. 159A, § 7 for the operation of motor vehicles over certain public ways in the City of Cambridge, the Metropolitan District Commission and the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority.

D.P.U. 91-88-A

Petition of Boston-Cambridge Trolley Tours, Inc., d/b/a Boston Trolley Tours, Inc. requesting that the Department of Public Utilities issue it a certificate of public convenience and necessity restricted to sight-seeing in the City of Cambridge, pursuant to G.L. c. 159A, § 7.

ORDER TO CORRECT A SPECIFIED ROUTE

On January 2, 1992, Boston-Cambridge Trolley Tours, Inc. ("Petitioner") requested that the Department of Public Utilities ("Department") correct a typographical error in the specified route of two of its Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN"), CPCN No. 3828 issued December 12, 1990 in D.P.U. 90-39 authorizing common carrier service and CPCN No. 3834 issued November 4, 1991 in D.P.U. 91-88 authorizing sight-seeing service. The specified route in the City of Cambridge is identical in both CPCNs. In both CPCNs lines 3 and 4 of the specified route in the City of Cambridge is given as: On Massachusetts Avenue between Alewife Brook Parkway and Mellen Street. The correct route is: On Massachusetts Avenue

between Alewife Brook Parkway and Memorial Drive. Line 5: On Mellen Street and back to Massachusetts Avenue, is correct. The municipal street license issued to the Petitioner by the City of Cambridge correctly authorizes Memorial Drive. See D.P.U. 90-39 (1990).

ORDER

Accordingly, after consideration it is ORDERED that:

The specified route of CPCN No. 3828 and CPCN No. 3834 in the City of Cambridge is:

IN CAMBRIDGE:

On Alewife Brook Parkway between Rindge Avenue and Massachusetts Avenue

On Massachusetts Avenue between Alewife Brook Parkway and Memorial Drive

On Mellen Street and back to Massachusetts Avenue

On Waterhouse Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Garden Street

On Peabody Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Cambridge Street

On Cambridge Street between Peabody Street and Massachusetts Avenue

On Mason Street between Garden Street and Brattle Street

On Brattle Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Mount Auburn Street

On Mount Auburn Street between Massachusetts Avenue and the Cambridge-Watertown city line

On University Place between Mount Auburn Street and Bennett Street

On Bennett Street between University Place and Elliot Street

On Elliot Street between Brattle Street and J.F.K. Street

On J.F.K. Street between Brattle Street and Memorial Drive

On Bow Street between Massachusetts Avenue and DeWolfe Street

On DeWolfe Street between Bow Street and Memorial Drive

On Garden Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Concord Avenue

On Concord Avenue between Fresh Pond Parkway and Garden Street

On Pleasant Street between Memorial Drive and the Hiatt Hotel

On Magazine Street between Memorial Drive and Granite Street
On Granite Street between Magazine Street and Brookline
Street
On Brookline Street between Granite Street and Memorial
Drive
On Amesbury Street between Memorial Drive and Vassar Street
On Vassar Street between Amesbury Street and Main Street
On Main Street between Massachusetts Avenue and Longfellow
Bridge
On Broadway between Western Connector and Longfellow Bridge
On Western Connector between Main Street and Binney Street
On Binney Street between Western Connector and First Street
On Third Street between Broadway and Binney Street
On First Street between Commercial Avenue and Cambridge
Street
On Cambridge Street between First Street and Monsignor
O'Brien Highway.

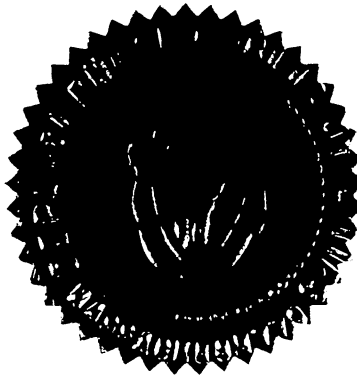

Appeal as to matters of law from any final decision, order or ruling of the Commission may be taken to the Supreme Judicial Court by an aggrieved party in interest by the filing of a written petition praying that the Order of the Commission be modified or set aside in whole or in part.

Such petition for appeal shall be filed with the Secretary of the Commission within twenty days after the date of service of the decision, order or ruling of the Commission, or within such further time as the Commission may allow upon request filed prior to the expiration of twenty days after the date of service of said decision, order or ruling. Within ten days after such petition has been filed, the appealing party shall enter the appeal in the Supreme Judicial Court sitting in Suffolk County by filing a copy thereof with the Clerk of said Court.
