As a permanent resident, condominium occupant and taxpayer of Cambridge, I would like to express my full support for the proposed development of a hotel to be operated by the Hyatt Hotel Corporation in Cambridge on the site of the Jordan Marsh warehouse.

Although I am opposed to most high-rise development in Cambridge, this development appears to me to be particularly well suited to its proposed site and to the pressing needs of Cambridge for increased tax revenue and employment opportunity. Because of its location on the river and its distance from residential communities, it would appear to me to offer Cambridge the advantages of a successful hotel operation without detriment to its immediate surroundings.

I urge you to limit your proposed changes in the Cambridge zoning ordinance so as to allow this project to proceed.
