Ordered: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to check the timing of the stoplight at the corner of Chauncy and Mass Ave to ensure that the Walk signal is properly timed as not to overlap with the Yellow light, and that a police car be stationed frequently at this intersection to ticket cars who run the red light thus endangering pedestrians.

Ordered: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to adjust the Pedestrian signals at the Harvard Square crossing on the Nini's Corner side so that it is visible from all points on the Out of Town side of the street, and be it further

Ordered: That if it is not possible to see this sign from all points in the designated crosswalk, that a second set of signals be installed, and be it further

Ordered: That the City Manger confer with the Director of Traffic and Parking to take steps to ensure that the traffic signals are visible to autos travelling northbound through this intersection, and be it further

Ordered: That the City Manager confer with the Director of Traffic and Parking with a view to shortening the signal cycle at this interesection so that the wait for the Walk signal is less than currently exists, and be it further

Ordered: That a Police officer be routinely stationed at this intersection to issue citation to motorists who run the light and warn pedestrians who jaywalk.
