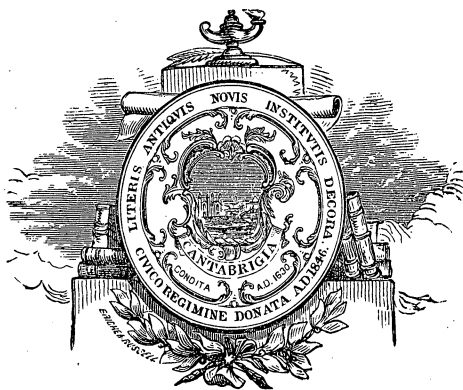




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 20. 1885

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Portland Street, so-called, extending from Main Street, in a direction nearly South, to Albany Street,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land

in width between *fifty feet* *said Main Street and Albany Street*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by

C. F. Bowker, dated, November 30. 1885,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the* several owners of abutting lands, having waived the usual notice and agreed in writing to claim no damages on account of such taking.
