If permission is given, we will erect a temporary structure. Celebration will begin as soon as building is ready and will continue through the season.

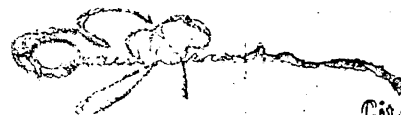

Harten of 16 Howard Street a parcel of land located on Montague Street as shown on Assessors Block Plan #126, lots numbered #19-#20-#21, for the purpose of erecting a temporary structure to hold an educational Chatauqua and celebrate the 300th anniversary of the landing of the Colored people in America. Said lease to run for a term of ONE YEAR.

Said land being the property of the City of Cambridge and containing approximately 12,000 square feet.
