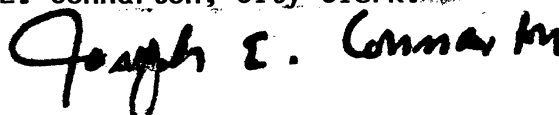

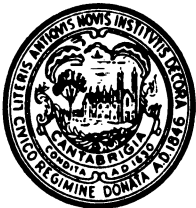

To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$279,604.00 in the Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Public Health to the Human Services Department Salary & Wages Account \$139,993.00, Other Ordinary Maintenance Account \$131,971.00 and Travel & Training Account \$7,640.00. The purpose of the grant is to initiate a multi disciplinary approach involving city officials, educators, law enforcement, health care workers, parents, religious organizations, substance abuse service providers, business and community based organization. Specific components of the grant include the development of neighborhood prevention networks, media campaigns, facilitating employee assistance programs among businesses and participation in a national evaluation effort.
