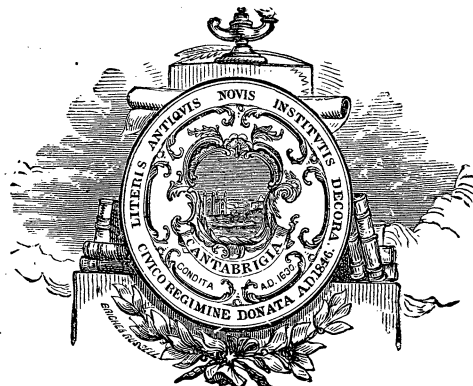

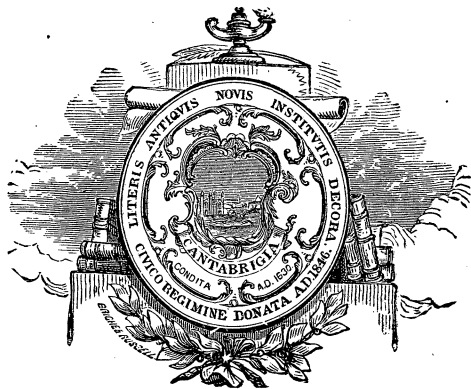

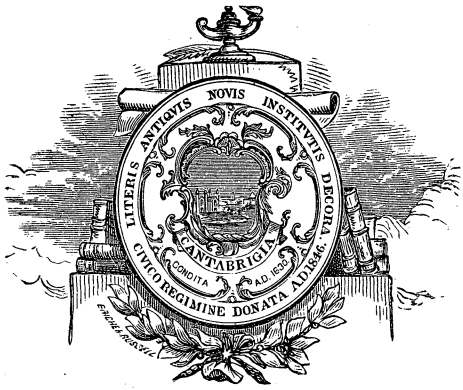

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

May 7. 1889.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Union Street, so called,
extending from Hampshire Street to Lincoln Street,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty feet*
in width between *Hampshire Street and Lincoln Street*,

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason for*
Surveyor, dated *July 13. 1887*,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,
the several owners of abutting lands having waived the usual
order, ~~and~~ assented to such laying out, and agreed to claim
no damages on account thereof.

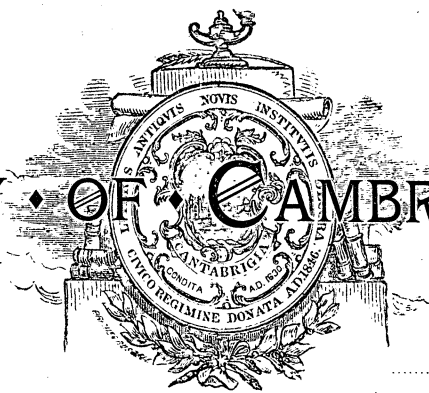
