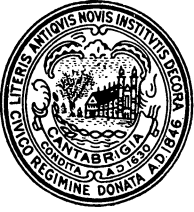

I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$145.63 to reimburse Robert Lukosunas, an employee of the Public Works Department for damages in this amount.

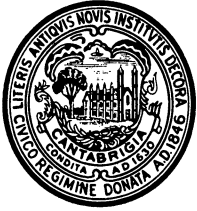


To the Honorable, the City Council,
