ORDERED: That the City Manager be requested to take immediate steps to assess the value of Cable Television for Cambridge and report back with a recommendation at the earliest possible date, and be it further

ORDERED: That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is requested to call a hearing on the entire issue of Cable Television for Cambridge.
