







Please bring before the City Councillors
attention at the August 1, 1994 Council meeting
the following attached petition signed by
homeowners who are abutters and near-
abutters, within 300 feet distance, from the
borders of the parcel of land, about 1 acre
in size, owned by Memorial Realty Trust,
at the Stop & Shop site, Memorial Drive and
Magazine St.

Said parcel, by petition for zoning change
by Richards et al, is requested to be
rezoned as Business A, and includes a portion
of Riverside Road, a city owned street. It is currently
zoned as Residence C.

We oppose such a zoning change, via the
attached petition, consisting of 5 pages attached.
It is our understanding, that given the opposition
of 20% of the abutters and near-abutters within
said 300 foot distance, a seventh council vote
is necessary for approval of any such zoning
change.

We, the undersigned, are owners of homes within 300 feet of the proposed zoning change in petition of Richards et al. (Memorial Realty Trust) to upzone part of the Stop & Shop property on Memorial Drive, adjacent to residential homes, from "Residence C" (35 ft. height maximum) to "Business A" (85 ft. height maximum). We wish to go on record opposing this upzoning.
