- WHEREAS: Since the nullification of subsection C 1/2 of the Rent Control Ordinance, more than 400 units of which have been sold; and
- WHEREAS: The sale of every individual rent controlled unit requires that the new owner register the property at the rent control office along with rent receipts, and the names of all beneficiaries relate to any trust connected to the property; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to obtain a report from the Executive Director of the Rent Control Department the documenting the number of units sold and the number of the number of units for which the requisite documentation has not been completed; and be it further
- ORDERED: That it is the sense of the City Council that the Rent Control Department continue its process of notifying each new owner of the necessity to register the property with the Rent Control Board.
