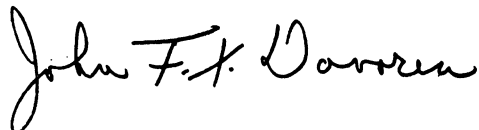

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

Operating without profit, and to the extent permissible in order to qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501 (c). (3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code, as now enacted or hereinafter amended:

to provide instruction and training to qualified persons in dramatic arts and film making and in other scientific and educational areas related thereto;

to compose and produce informational, documentary, and scientific films for educational institutions and purposes; and

to encourage and finance research in dramatic arts, film production and the use of visual and other media for educational purposes; and to put into practice the results of such research.

Section 4. (Cont'd)

(f) Membership and the rights and qualifications thereof, as well as the provisions for the management of the corporation not inconsistent with the foregoing, shall be set forth in the By-Laws of the corporation.

(g) Except as required by law, meetings of the members and of the directors may be held outside of Massachusetts.

(h) The corporation shall have, and may exercise in furtherance of its purposes, the powers set forth specified in paragraphs (e), (f), (h) and (j) of section 9 of chapter 156B of the General Laws, provided that no such power may be exercised in a manner inconsistent with chapter 180 of the General Laws or any other provisions of applicable federal or state law.

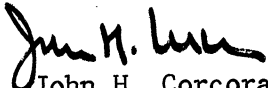
