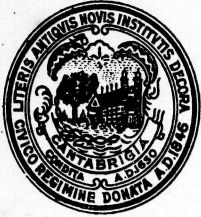

To the Honorable, the City Council:

I refer to the following order of the City Council passed on July 29, 1946:

"ORDERED:- That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with the Metropolitan District Commission, relative to the location of a Bus Stop on Rindge Avenue and Alewife Brook Parkway, although the Metropolitan District Commission refused this stop to the Boston Elevated Railway by letter to the City Council on April 8, 1946, under War-time powers this could be allowed for the benefit of the new residents of Veterans Housing at Jerry's Pit."
