Janice (Graeff) Miller of Winchester, who was in private practice as a social worker, died late Saturday night, June 14, 1997 at Fletcher Allen Health Care Hospital in Burlington, Vermont.

She died several hours after being struck by an automobile while crossing Route 2 in South Hero, Vermont, where she was vacationing with her husband and daughter.

Mrs. Miller was born in Englewood, New Jersey, in 1957 and was a graduate of Lesley College. She received her master's degree in social work from Boston College in 1986. Prior to establishing her own practice, she had been a clinical supervisor in the Employee Assistance Program at Mount Auburn Hospital from 1986 to 1994.

Mrs. Miller was the wife of the John F. Miller, a principal in the local firm HMFH Architects Inc., and the mother of Elizabeth Abigail (Abby) Miller, their 6-month-old daughter. She was an active member of the Cambridge Friends School community, where she served as a classroom parent and as an organizer of the annual auction.
