To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report #3 regarding the disposal of large appliance items, the Commissioner of Public Works David Haley advises me of the following:

The white goods fee of \$15.00 per appliance was implemented on January 1, 1992. Senior citizens are given a 33% discount and charged \$10.00 per item. There is no waiver of the fee for low income families.

In the first full year of the program, 1,645 individual items were picked up throughout the City, producing \$22,915.00 in total revenue. A total of 341 stickers were issued to senior citizens.

The system as currently in place seems to be working well.
