ORDERED: That, in the process of searching for a new location for the Auxiliary Fire Department, the City Manager explore with appropriate sources of authority whether, as some suggest, that Federal funds are available to municipal Auxiliary Fire Departments provided that certain criteria are given compliance and, if so, the cost of a new Auxiliary Headquarters site here in Cambridge could be lessened significantly; and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report back to the City Council on this matter at his early convenience.
