- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of the Reverend Joseph P. Dropski, Pastor of St. Joseph's Church in Woburn and former Juvenile Counsellor for Middlesex County; and
- WHEREAS: Father Dropski, a Priest for thirty years, served the Archdiocese of Boston as Secretary of the Priest's Senate from 1976-1978, coordinating the communication between the priests of the diocese and the Cardinal-Archbishop, and also had served from 1955-1956 as Prefect of Discipline in St. Clement's Hall at St. John's Seminary; and
- WHEREAS: Father Dropski was known among his peers as a jovial, hard-working priest, who although stern, was fair; and
- WHEREAS: A Lynn native, Father Dropski was ordained by the late Richard Cardinal Cushing in 1956 and was later assigned as Assistant Pastor to St. Monica's Church in Methuen, remaining there until he was appointed Associate Pastor of St. John's Church in Beverly, and in 1978 was named Pastor of St. Edward's Church in Brockton; and
- WHEREAS: Father Dropski possessed a true commitment to religion, charity and education, always availing himself to those in need, particularly troubled youth and the unfortunate of the Archdiocese; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending their deepest sympathy to Sister Joan Dropski and the entire Dropski family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Sister Joan Dropski on behalf of the entire City Council.
