In City Council,

October 20, 1969.

ORDERED:-

That the City Council go on record applauding the action of twenty Democratic legislators in the Great and General Court, including Representative Charles Flaherty of Cambridge and Representative Michael Dukakis of Brookline in requesting Governor Sargent -

- 1) To halt all further construction of the Master Highway Plan Expressway system inside Route 128;
- 2) To issue an immediate order to the D.P.W. to halt further land acquisition and demolition along the route of the proposed Southwest Expressway;
- 3) To support steps to channel more money on a permanent basis from the state highway fund back to the cities and towns;
- 4) To formulate plans for a greatly expanded mass transis system to meet the transportation needs of the Eastern Massachusetts area;
- ~~5) To build highways in appropriate locations in the central and western parts of the State where highways are needed and mass transit is inappropriate for obvious reasons.~~
