- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on the Arts and Humanities has honored the American Repertory Theatre; and
- WHEREAS: The American Repertory Theatre was singled out as one of thirty-four organizations of 428 Merit Aid applicants for outstanding achievement in providing programs and services for the citizens of the state and for playing a leadership role in enriching the cultural life of Massachusetts; and
- WHEREAS: In describing the reasons for the honor, the Council said: "American Repertory Theatre, Cambridge, has taken regional theatre and put it on the intellectual cutting edge of world theatre. At the same time, ART has demonstrated that an audience can be developed for risk-taking theatre productions and has stimulated more adventurous theatrical activity across the state;" therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council honors and congratulates the American Repertory Theatre for this recognition and its fine work in the community; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the to the American Repertory Theatre.
