- WHEREAS: Walter, born to the parents of Michael A. ("Mickey the Dude") Sullivan and Mary C. (Hart) on March 2, 1923 followed both his father and brother into a life of active politics beginning in 1951 when he was elected to the Massachusetts House of Representatives; and
- WHEREAS: Walter's long tenure on the City Council began in 1959, serving twenty-four consecutive years, including two terms as Mayor and Chairman of the School Committee during the periods of 1968-1969 and 1974-1975; and
- WHEREAS: Walter J. Sullivan has spent his entire adult life in the pursuit of making others happy or providing some assistance or guidance in a way that has become synonymous with the "Sullivan" name; now therefore be it
