Dear Mr. Sullivan:

As you are undoubtedly aware, the site of the former Russell School on Grozier and Larch Roads has been the subject of discussion and study regarding future use for nearly four years. Your office was furnished with a copy of the detailed study of potential uses which was previously prepared by this committee. We have written to the Superintendent of Schools today to inform him that the committee has unanimously agreed upon the following stand:

The site of the former Russell School should be developed for single-family and two-family residences with the lots to be sold be bid to individuals, giving preference to Cambridge residents. Sufficient open space should be set aside and a portion of the proceeds should be reserved to provide for the recreational needs of the neighborhood. This plan will improve the tax base of the city while enhancing the existing neighborhood.

We hope that you will support this constructive position. Representatives of this committee would be happy to meet with you at your convenience to explain the background of the situation.
