days from date.

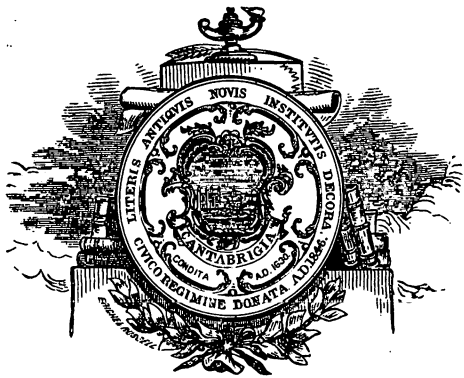

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

July 29. 1887.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that *Highland Street, so-called as extended from Appleton Street to Sparks Street,*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *Forty feet* in width between *Appleton Street and Sparks Street,*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. A. Mason Junr. Surveyor,* and dated *July 25. 1887.*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,

Provided, that within *Sixty* ~~thirty~~ days from the date hereof, the owners of lands abutting on said *Highland Street* shall file a satisfactory release of the same, with the City Clerk.
