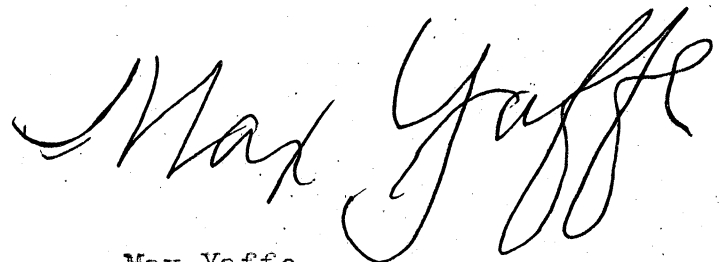
Gentlemen;-
